What is a 3-Sentence Summary?

An easy way to discuss important health information with your healthcare team at each visit

How do I use it?

- Sentence 1: My age and brief medical history
Sentence 2: My treatment plan
- Sentence 3: My question/concern to talk about during this visit

Example:

"Hi, my name is Daniel.

I am 15 years old and I have a mitochondrial disorder.

I can't eat orally, so I am fed through my g-tube.

I am here today because the skin around my g-tube is sore and red".
